2013 Boat Parade Guidelines

1. By Minnesota State law, all individuals will have a PFD (Personal Floating Device) readily available. Boats will be checked by a committee member or law enforcement prior to the start of the parade.
2. Operators of the boats will have a clear view 360 degrees around the boat.
3. No type of fireworks and/or pyrotechnics will be used on any boat prior, during, or after the boat parade; to include anything that simulates a fire or smoke onboard a boat.
4. After launching, boats will line up starting at the School Road Bridge.
5. The parade will start at 7:00 p.m., no exceptions.
6. All boats must agree to the above guidelines or they will not be allowed in the parade.

If there are any violations of the above guidelines, it will result in the cancelling of the following year's boat parade.
